Exhibition	<p>The <i>Drawing Restraint Archive</i> includes sculptures, vitrines, videos and drawings arising from his <i>Drawing Restraint</i> performances. Along with three monumental sculptures, the archive will be shown in dialogue with over 70 northern renaissance artworks (artists include Martin Schongauer, Urs Graf, Lucas Cranach).</p> <p>Matthew Barney's <i>Drawing Restraint</i> series previously consisted of sixteen works. As part of the exhibition, exclusive to Schaulager and not touring, two new works by the artist will be shown in public for the first time: <i>Drawing Restraint 17</i> and <i>Drawing Restraint 18</i>, created in May 2010 especially for Schaulager.</p>
