Ever since it was established in 1933, the Foundation has been devoted to the collection and presentation of contemporary art. The exhibition FUTURE PRESENT, covering over 5000 m<sup>2</sup>, will be on view not only in Schaulager's unique galleries but in other rooms on the premises as well. Works from the Foundation are also permanently installed in public spaces in and around Basel.
